WHAT IS FAMILY LEARNING?

Wandsworth Council currently delivers Family Learning courses in a wide range of venues including libraries, community and voluntary organisations.

In addition to this we are working with over 30 primary and secondary schools, as well as South Thames College.

Family Learning Programmes support fun learning activities and are available for parents, grandparents, carers and can involve other family members. Courses aim to give parents/carers confidence in being involved in their children's education.
